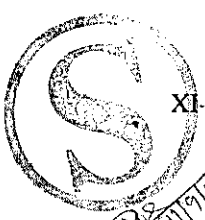

	<u>SB : Hon'ble Shri Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, J.</u> <u>06-09-2012</u> Shri Sudeep Johri, counsel for the petitioner. Shri Arun Sao, Government Advocate for the State / respondents 1, 2 and 4 on advance copy. Heard. The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of direction to official respondents to divide retiral dues of deceased Government Servant – Hazarilal between the petitioner and respondent No.3 in equal ratio on the submission that while Hazarilal was alive, he had applied for nomination in favour of the petitioner. Who would be entitled to get retiral dues, is essentially dependent upon the nomination made by the Government Servant. If the claim of the petitioner is that before death, Hazarilal had requested for change of name of nomination and on that basis, the petitioner is entitled to get equal ratio of retiral dues, it is for the petitioner to approach the concerned authority by making suitable representation. In the absence of any approach made by the petitioner to the concerned authority, I am not inclined to entertain this petition at this stage. Leaving the petitioner to work out her remedy by moving representation before the concerned authority, this petition is finally disposed off.
