The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing the FIR No.122 dated 7.6.2012 (Annexure P-1), registered under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Phase-1, Mohali and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise reached between the parties.

Heard.

While issuing the notice of motion, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for getting their statements recorded.

In compliance of the order dated 22.10.2013, report of CJM, Mohali dated 18.11.2013, has been received. The learned CJM has recorded his satisfaction and averred that the compromise effected

between the parties is out of their free will and without any coercion and it is valid compromise. The statements of the parties are appended with the said report.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 also admits the factum of compromise and states that the complainant has no objection, if the FIR in question is quashed.

In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in continuing the proceedings. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and FIR No.122 dated 7.6.2012 (Annexure P-1), registered under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Phase-1, Mohali and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
