	<u>SB : Hon'ble Shri Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, J.</u> <u>24-12-14</u> A.N. Pandey, counsel for the petitioner/s. Shri Y.S.Thakur, Dy.A.G. for the State. Through this petition, the petitioner has prayed for direction to respondents to consider petitioner's application for grant of appropriate benefit including benefit of compassionate appointment under the scheme of rehabilitation for those, who have been affected by naxalite movement. It is submitted that though the Superintendent of Police specified the petitioner as naxalite affected, petitioner's application is still pending consideration. From the certificate of the Superintendent of police, Balrampur, prima facie, the claim of the petitioner does not appear to be frivolous and therefore, requires consideration. Learned Dy.A.G. submits that petitioner's application would be considered in accordance with the existing scheme of grant of benefit to naxalite affected person. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to take into consideration petitioner's application under Government's scheme for rehabilitation of persons affected in naxalite operations. The decision may be taken as early as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
