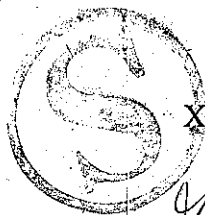

Shri Shiv Sahu, counsel for respondent No.5. Heard. The petitioner has filed this petition seeking direction to respondents to release the retiral dues of her husband – Lala Ram Rathia whose civil death has been declared by the First Civil Judge, Class II, Raigarh in Civil Suit No.50-A/09 vide judgment decree dated 30/08/11. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once there is a declaration passed by the competent Court, the department is obliged under the law to proceed to release retiral dues treating her husband having died civil death. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner's application would be considered and in view of declaration of the Civil Court, appropriate steps shall be taken towards settlement of the dues to which the petitioner is entitled as a widow of Lala Ram Rathia (died civil death). In view of the aforesaid submission, this petition at present is disposed off with a direction to the State to settle the dues and make necessary payment to the petitioner treating her husband as
