	<u>SB : Hon'ble Shri Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, J.</u> <u>24-12-14</u> Shri Manoj Jaiswal, counsel for the petitioner/s. Shri Prasunn Bhaduri, Govt. Adv. for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefit of regular pay scale has not been granted to the petitioner from the initial date of appointment. It is submitted that earlier, the petitioner had filed a petition before this Court in which a direction was issued on 28/06/11 to consider petitioner's representation in the light of orders passed by this Court from time to time, but till date, benefit has not been granted to the petitioner. This Court has already issued a direction to respondents to consider petitioner's claim and take a decision within a period of three months vide order dated 28/06/11. If the concerned respondent, obliged to comply the order of the Court, has not taken any decision in the matter, then proper remedy of the petitioner is to take appropriate steps to file contempt petition rather than repeating the same petition. The second petition is not maintainable and is accordingly dismissed, however, with liberty to the petitioner to take remedy for compliance of the direction issued by this Court earlier.
