	<u>SB : Hon'ble Shri Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, J.</u> <u>24-12-14</u> Shri V.K.Pandey, counsel for the petitioner/s. Shri Prasunn Bhaduri, Govt Adv. for the State. Heard. The petitioner has challenged order dated 20/11/14 by which he has been posted in Sub-Division, Pakhanjur. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been transferred vide order dated 15/07/14 from Sukma to Kanker and he submitted his joining in the divisional office and he was again transferred from Kanker to Pakhanjur within a short period of eight days. A perusal of order dated 15/07/14 shows that the petitioner was transferred from one division to another division. Obviously, posting of the petitioner is given by the divisional officer. This has been done on 15/07/14, therefore, it is not a case of frequent transfer but it is merely a posting of the petitioner to Division. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at Pakhanjur, there is no proper medical facility and the petitioner and his wife are suffering from health problems. That is a matter for the petitioner to approach the competent authority and not this Court. With the said liberty to file representation before the competent authority, the petition is dismissed.
