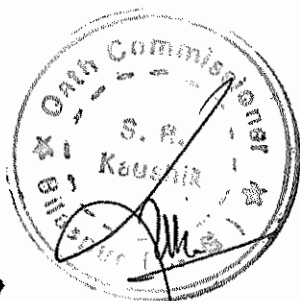

Shri K.A.Ansari, Senior Counsel along with Shri Devesh Kela, counsel for respondent No.1. Shri Prasunn Bhaduri, Govt. Adv. for the State / respondent No.2. Withholding of increments has brought the petitioner to this Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the increment has been wrongly withheld. Perusal of memo dated 06/08/13 (Annexure P/10) shows that the University has not taken any final decision and are awaiting decision on audit objections in the matter. Therefore, the petition, at this stage, is premature. The petitioner has approached this Court because ever since then, no final decision has been taken. The respondent / University should take final decision in the claim of the petitioner within a period of three months and pass a speaking order. In case, benefit is not extended to the petitioner, it will be open for the petitioner to take remedy available under the law. The petition is finally disposed off.
