COMMON ORDER

All the petitioners herein are working as Sub-Inspectors of Police. The grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled to be included in the panel prepared for the promotion as Inspectors of Police for the year 2014-2015. Therefore, they made representations to the fourth respondent on 19.06.2014 and the same are pending consideration. Hence, the petitioners have filed these writ petitions.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners have given representations to the fourth respondent seeking to include them in the promotion panel. Therefore, the said representations will have to be considered.

3. Considering the submission made, without going into the merits of the case, the fourth respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on the pending representations of the petitioners dated 19.06.2014, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. These writ petitions are disposed of accordingly. However, there is no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

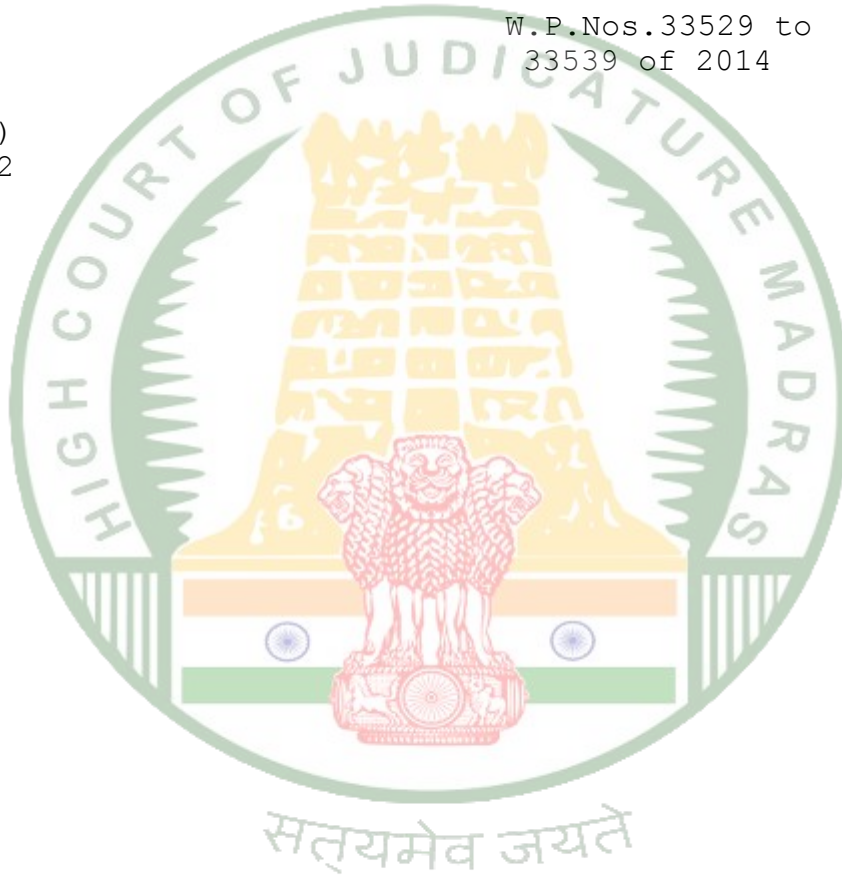
