It is further represented by the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) that the representation of the petitioner dated 26.11.2014 will be taken into consideration at the time of investigation.



4.The above statement of the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), who is appearing for the respondents, is recorded.

5. Even though the petitioner has approached this Court at pre-mature stage, the petitioner need not apprehend any adverse report. Depending upon the outcome of the investigation, the names of the said accused persons will be included.

6. In view of the above, no further order is required and this Criminal Original Petition is closed.
