PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is the sole accused in Crime No.125 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police, for offence under Sections 406 and 420 I.P.C. The petitioner was under judicial custody from 25.11.2014. He has come forward with this petition seeking bail.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is under judicial custody for the past 34 days and hence, he seeks bail for the petitioner.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner was working as a sales representative in the defacto complainant's company and he misappropriated a sum of Rs.1,30,000/-.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submissions made by both sides, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

5. In the result, this petition is ordered and bail is granted to the petitioner on the following conditions: -

(i) The Petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Madurai; and

(ii) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily twice at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30 p.m. until further orders.
