PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

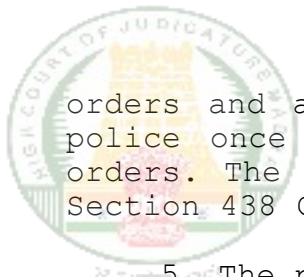
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/A.1 and A.2 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294 (b), 323, 355 and 506(ii) I.P.C. and r/w Section 4 of Tamilnadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act in Crime No.139 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioners.

3.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that there is a family dispute between the petitioners and the defacto complainant with regard to partition and the accused abused the defacto complainant with filthy language.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alangudi and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 1 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police daily twice at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30 p.m. until further



orders and and the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e. on every Monday at 10.30a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
