The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for a *Mandamus* to set aside proceedings No.Ref.B/5307/2014, dated 16.09.2014, of respondent No.3.

Considering the fact that the impugned order was passed more than 3 ½ months back, I do not propose to adjudicate on the legality or otherwise of the same. However, respondent No.3 is directed to complete the enquiry by following the procedure explained in ***Smt B.Manjula Vs. District Collector, Civil Supplies, Kurnool*** (Writ Petition No.32713 of 2011, dated 26.11.2014) and pass a final order within six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In order to enable respondent No.3 to follow the said judgment, a copy thereof shall be enclosed.

As a sequel to disposal of the Writ Petition,
WPMP.No.51352 of 2014 filed by the petitioner for interim
relief is disposed of as infructuous.
