AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.49 dated 13.05.2013 registered under Sections 307, 382 & 34 IPC and under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Old Shalley, District Gurdaspur.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused took out pistol and asked the complainant to hand over all money he had and looted Rs.8000/- from him.

Custody certificate filed in Court by way of affidavit of

Davinder Kumar Sidhu, Officiating Superintendent, Central Jail, Gurdaspur is taken on record, wherein it has been certified that the petitioner has already undergone of 01 year 07 months 01 days.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire factual matrix and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
