Petitioner Bharpoor Singh alias Bhura has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.163 dated 24.10.2014 under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506, 333 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Deepak Grewal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and contests the petition. Police record is available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the FIR, only *lalkara* has been attributed to the present petitioner. He has not caused any injury. The petitioner is in custody since 24.10.2014. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Court.
