This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.461 dated 29.11.2014 under Sections 409 and 420 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bahadurgarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He is not involved in any manner as the petitioner was working as Clerk in the PGT Branch and his job was to make paid tax entries in Gatta copies of vehicle, after receiving cash receipt of tax deposited by the vehicle owner before the competent authority. He further submits that neither any amount has been received by the petitioner being clerk nor any embezzlement has been made by him.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the inquiry

was made by the officer and the petitioner was called to join the inquiry proceedings but in spite of repeated calls he did not join the inquiry. The petitioner has not only made bogus entries in Gatta copies of vehicle but in demand register also bogus entries of crore of rupees have been made, therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the State and keeping in view the amount involved and the findings recorded in the inquiry report, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
