Petitioner Gurdeep Singh alias Sonu has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.250 dated 10.10.2014 under Section 354 IPC and Section 8 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that a false FIR has been registered against the present petitioner as there is also civil and criminal litigation pending between the parties.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Deepak Grewal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and contests the petition. Police record is available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the allegations against present petitioner Gurdeep Singh alias Sonu is that he tried to outrage the modesty of the prosecutrix, aged about 9-10 years, who is grand daughter of the complainant Gian Singh.

The petitioner is in custody since 10.10.2014. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Court.
