2 02-02-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

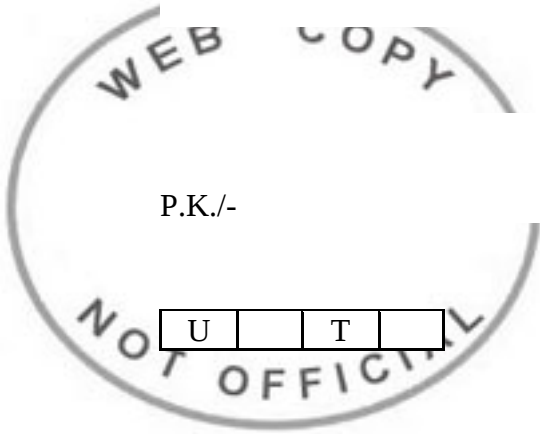
Petitioner is languishing in custody since 20.08.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-B) a, 26 of the Arms Act and 3/4 of the Explosive Substance Act.

It is alleged that from the possession of the petitioner two used cartridges were recovered.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that statement has been made in para-3 of the petition that he has no criminal antecedent.
