ORAL ORDER

2 04-02-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody since 30.10.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and 27(b) (ii) of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act.

It is alleged that that on 21st July 2014 the medicine shops of the petitioner and Sri Ram Mishra were raided by the informant being a Drug Inspector along with other associates. The petitioner was found present in the shop but he failed to produce any valid license. Huge quantity of medicines was recovered from the shop of the petitioner including prohibited medicine.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that it is not alleged that seized medicine were either misbranded, adulterated or spurious. The petitioner had a valid

license for sale of medicine earlier but the same could not be renewed on the alleged date of seizure. Statement has been made in para-3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Moreover, the co-accused Sri Ram Mishra has been granted bail by a Bench of this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 42856 of 2014.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Sadar Motihari in connection with Dumariyaghat P.S. Case No. 80 of 2014.
