2 10-02-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 406, 420/34 of IPC.

Allegation against the petitioner is to have taken
Rs.5000/- each from 10 persons for the grant of money in Indira
Awas Scheme but no money has been given to beneficiaries.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been in custody
since 17.10.2014. Charge-sheet has already been submitted and
there is no chance of tampering with the witnesses.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the above
named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing
bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand only) with two sureties of

the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Birpur, District- Supaul/court concerned in Nirmali P. S. Case No. 147 of 2014 **after framing of charge** with following conditions:-

1. The petitioner will not indulge himself in similar or any other offence.
2. One of the bailors must be the close relative of the petitioner.
3. The petitioner will be well represented in the Court on each and every date and in case of absence for two consecutive dates or in case of violation of terms of bail, his bail bond would be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
