No one appears on behalf of the petitioner to press this application when the case is called out, while Sri Vijay Kumar Bhagat, learned counsel for the opposite party is present.

Learned counsel for the opposite party submits that the present application has been filed to transfer Matrimonial (Divorce) Case No.05 of 1990 filed on behalf of the opposite party from the court of Civil Courts Darbhanga to the Civil Courts Dumka.
