Annexure- 1 is very clear as to the nature of the engagement of the petitioner. There is not even clear indication or assertion in the writ application that even if Annexure- 3 was issued on 23.11.1988, the same was implemented or the petitioner was allowed to work in new capacity as a Khalasi. It is a speculative kind of writ application without the necessary facts being available whether the petitioner has worked even as a Khalasi for substantial period of time to bring him within the ambit of the circular which laid down the

guidelines under which such engagements can be regularized.

Writ application has no merit. It is dismissed.
