3 27-04-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the deceased, who died in mysterious circumstances within seven years of her marriage at the house of the petitioner and there is allegation of cruelty against the petitioner due to non fulfillment of dowry demand, accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in connection with Sidhwalia P.S.Case No. 43 of 2014, pending in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj stands rejected.

However, learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj is directed to commit the case of the petitioners to the court of session in accordance with law within two weeks from the date of

receipt/ production of copy of this order and after that the session court should expedite the trial of the petitioners and try to conclude the same as early as possible.
