Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420,
467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that maternal-grand-father of the
informant transferred the land in favour of informant but the
petitioner got the land mutated in his favour fraudulently.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the informant is his own brother and father of the petitioner
has admitted that the land is joint family property and it was
transferred in the name of informant since petitioner was minor
at the relevant time. Moreover, with regard to the alleged land,
Partition Suit No. 138 of 2013 and Mutation Case No. 5 of
2013 are pending.

Considering the accusation in the background of a dispute of civil nature, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case No.251 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
