Having regard to the admitted position that in course of examination of the claim for appointment on compassionate ground the respondents have found that one of the son of the deceased employee, the father of the petitioner, was already in Government service, this Court would not find any error in the ultimate decision taken by the authorities refusing compassionate appointment to the petitioner. This aspect of the matter has already

been decided by the Division Bench of this Court in the case of Vishal Kumar vs. the State of Bihar & ors., reported in 2004(2) PLJR 453.

That being so, this application must fail and is hereby dismissed.
