counsels for the States of Bihar and Jharkhand.

The writ application has been filed for payment of
arrear of salary for the period from January, 1994 to July, 1998,
which was the period of suspension of the petitioner during which
he has been paid only 50% subsistence allowance.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per
instructions received by him the bills of the petitioner have finally
been passed and are pending before the Treasury, Munger.

The writ application is, accordingly, disposed of with a
direction to the Treasury Officer, Munger to ensure that the

amounts in question are paid to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
