Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
13.12.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 414 and 401/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Seven stolen mobiles were recovered from
the shop of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner runs a mobile shop and co-accused
Rajkana gave him for selling those mobiles. A statement has been
made in para 11 of the petition that neither the recovered mobile
nor the petitioner has been put on TIP.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Rampur P.S. Case No. 361 of 2014.
