2 19-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner,
informant and the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 12.12.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 472, 419 and 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the co-accused Dhrub Das persuaded the informant to purchase 17 decimals of land for which the informant paid Rs. 4,25,000/- but this petitioner by impersonating the original landholder Sandhya Rani executed the sale deed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is a lady, investigation has already concluded and statement has been made in paragraph no. 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent

whereas it is submitted by learned counsel for the informant that the petitioner executed sale deed by impersonating the original landholder and has committed forgery and thereby cheated Rs. 4,25,000/- of the informant.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady and investigation has already concluded, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Aurangabad, in connection with Aurangabad P.S. Case No. 380 of 2014.
