Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

The statement of victim has been recorded under section 164 of the Cr.P.C. Although she has stated in her statement that she was kidnapped by the petitioners but she admitted in her statement that after three days of alleged occurrence, she was dropped by the petitioners near canal of her village.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the above stated petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in Salkhua P.S. Case no. 31/2014.
