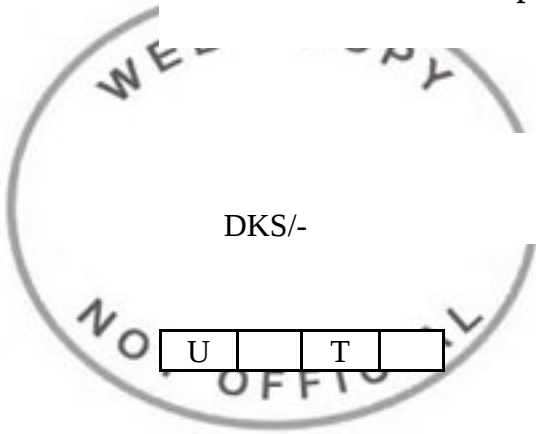
Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner being the husband of the complainant is languishing in custody since 18.09.2014 in a complaint case in which processes have been directed to be issued after cognizance being taken for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.
