2 22-01-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offence under sections 363/366 (A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering that there is no allegation against the petitioner of committed any misbehavior against the alleged victim and he is in custody since 18.07.2014 and the brother of the petitioner undertakes his responsibility, let the petitioner Subodh Paswan, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by the Court below to the satisfaction of Shri Uma Shankar, Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Danapur in connection with Naubatpur P.S.Case No., 126 of 2014 Subject to the conditions (i) That one of the bailors will be close

relative of the petitioner, who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the Court about any change in the address of the petitioner, ii) That the bailors shall also state on affidavit that they will inform the Court concerned if the petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding the cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse, iii) That the petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse, and iv) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled.
