furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the Railway Judicial Magistrate,

that one of the sureties must be close relative of the petitioner who
shall swear an affidavit before the concerned court disclosing this fact
as to how he is related with the petitioner.
