2 29-01-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the  
offences under sections 447, 448, 384, 386/34 of the Indian Penal  
Code and ¾ Explosive Substance Act .

Considering that apart from confessional statement,  
there is no any other material against the petitioner and brother of  
the petitioner Rupesh Kumar, undertakes his responsibility, let the  
petitioner Ramesh Kumar @ Tiger be released on bail on  
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand) with two  
sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by  
the Court below to the satisfaction of Shri S.K.Jha, learned  
Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> class, Sikrahana at Motihari ( East-



Champan) in connection with Trial No. 3205/2014 arising out of Chiraiya P.S.s. Case No. 264/2012 subject to the conditions (i) That one of the bailors will be close relative of the petitioner, who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the Court about any change in the address of the petitioner, ii) That the bailors shall also state on affidavit that they will inform the Court concerned if the petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding the cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse, iii) That the petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse, and iv) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled.

In view of the nature of allegations, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Superintendent of police, East Champaran, Motihari within fifteen days of his release with a copy of this order and every two weeks thereafter for the next nine

months. The conduct of the petitioner will be kept under watch in this period by the Superintendent of Police concerned and if it is found wanting in any respect, a report shall be made to the Court concerned by him to initiate a proceeding for cancellation of bail for reasons of misuse of bail. After reporting to the Superintendent of Police, East Chamaran, Motihari, a certificate will be filed by the petitioner before the court concerned.
