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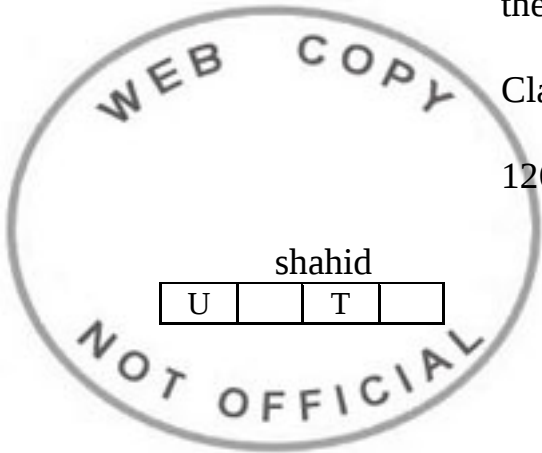

 learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

The contention on behalf of the petitioners is that only one witness, namely, Mahesh Kumar claimed himself to be eye-witness of alleged occurrence but taking note of statement of the above stated Mahesh Kumar, a coordinate bench of this court has already granted privilege of bail to co-accused Ramsarup Manjhi vide order dated 9.4.2013 passed in Cr. Misc. no.47119/2012.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of
