2 09-07-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
17.03.2015 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
sections 498 and 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

Accusation is of killing the daughter of the
informant by administering poison for non-fulfillment of dowry
demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the post-mortem reflects neither any injury nor the cause of
death has been ascertained and the investigation has already
concluded. The police papers have been submitted without
obtaining viscera report from the FSL.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Arrah in connection with Charpokhari P.S. Case No.81 of 2015.
