2 30-09-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 447, 323, 307, 504 of the Indian Penal Code. Later on Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was added.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was twice rejected by this Court. Considering the nature of allegations made against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within six months holding the trial on day-to-day basis.

The S.P., Muzaffarpur is directed to ensure the

attendance of the witnesses in Sessions Trial No. 238 of 2014,
arising out of Deoriya P.S. Case No. 41 of 2012, so that the trial
must be concluded within the stipulated time.
