Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the
State.

The Petitioner seeks bail in Dhaka P.S. Case No. 36 of
2012 registered under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code pending before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate,
Sikrahana at Motihari, East Champaran.

Considering the direct allegation against the
Petitioner in the First Information Report itself, I am not
inclined to grant him bail. The prayer for bail is rejected.

The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and
