Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a criminal prosecution registered under Sections 302, 307 and some other allied offences under the Indian Penal Code.

Though the petitioner is named in the F.I.R., vide Annexure-1, as an accused with an allegation of participation in the crime in question, but taking into consideration the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is general and omnibus in nature and no specific role has been assigned against her for committing the crime in question and further taking into consideration that the petitioner is a lady and is in judicial custody since 10.10.2014, her prayer for bail is allowed. The petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case No. 267 of 2014 & G.R. No. 4391 of 2014, subject to the conditions that:

- (A) One of the bailors must be government servant or close family member of the petitioner, who will

file an affidavit in the court below showing his/her relationship with the petitioner, if the petitioner is found involved in same and similar nature of cases in future, then in that case the informant/ prosecution shall be at liberty to file a petition for cancellation of the bail of the petitioner, and if such a petition is filed, the court below would be obliged to dispose of the same in accordance with law after giving opportunity of hearing to all concerned and

the petitioner shall make regular pairvi in the court below in the present case either by appearing himself in person or through representation by his lawyer on each and every dates, and if on two consecutive dates petitioner fails to make pairvi, then the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
