Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is not named in the first information report nor he
does have any criminal antecedent and while rejecting the prayer for
bail of the petitioner, learned Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Jamui
referred paragraphs-41, 42, 43 & 63 of the case diary but from perusal
of aforesaid paragraphs, I find that not a single prosecution witness
claimed to have seen the petitioner committing the alleged crime.
