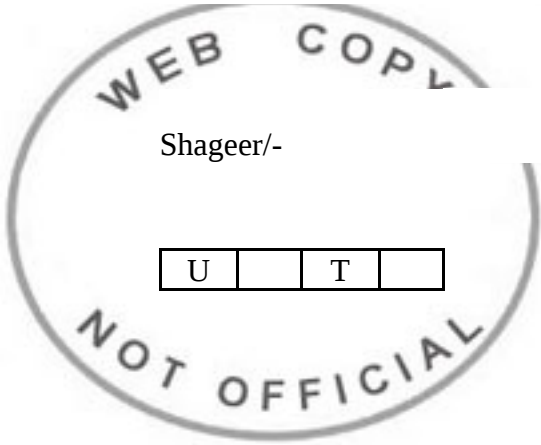
From the possession of the petitioner 1 ½ Kg Ganja was recovered and from the house of the petitioner 21 Kg Ganja was recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is 82 years old.

Considering the recovery being commercial quantity, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at present.

Accordingly the application is dismissed in connection with Patliputra P.S. Case No. 123 of 2014, Special Case No. 20 of 2014, pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Patna.
