Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners seek quashing of the order dated 18.8.2015 by which the 2nd Additional District & Sessions Judge, Lakhishari, has refused to discharge the Petitioner in Sessions Case No. 10 of 2015 arising out of Lakhisarai P.S. Case No. 248 of 2014.

Having considered the merits of the case, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application stands dismissed.
