2 11-08-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case under Section 304B and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased. The father of the deceased made allegation that his daughter was strangled to death by her husband and other in-laws.

It is submitted that no external injury was found on the deceased in the post mortem report and the doctor did not give any definite opinion with regard to cause of death. The viscera is preserved.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the nature of allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased, the above named petitioner is

directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Sanjay Singh, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Araria in Raniganj P.S. Case No. 58/ 2015.
