3 12-01-2015 Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offence under Sections 326, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.
Subsequently, Section 304(B) of the Indian Penal Code was
added.

Considering the nature of allegation against the
Petitioner, I am not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner in
connection with Vaishali P.S. Case No. 154 of 2013 pending
before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur, Distt.
Vaishali at Hajipur.

The prayer for bail is rejected.
