Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

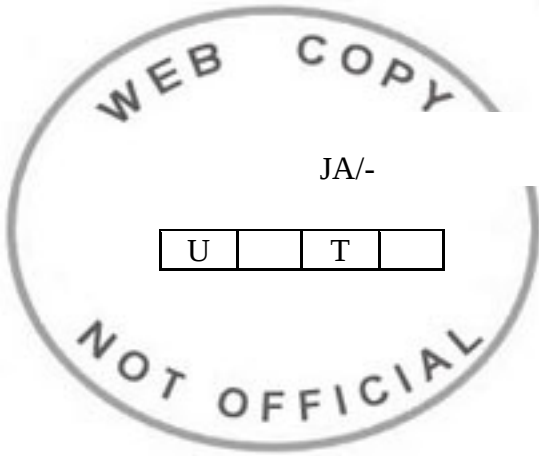
The Petitioner seeks bail in Lakhisarai P.S. Case No. 412 of 2013 giving rise to Sessions Trial No.89 of 2014 instituted under Section(s) 302 Indian Penal Code pending before the Additional Sessions Judge, Lakhisarai.

Considering the nature of allegation against the Petitioner, I am not inclined to grant him bail.

Prayer for bail is **rejected**.
