thrice by this Court.

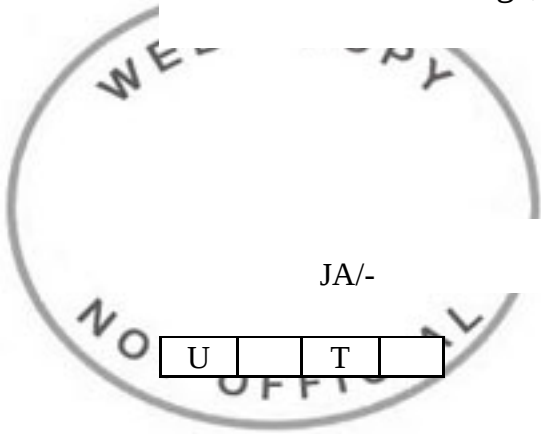
Perused the report of the Superintendent of Police,

examination of rest of the witnesses.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not  
inclined to review the earlier orders refusing bail to the Petitioner.
