ORAL ORDER

The petitioner is being tried for offence punishable under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner has been arrested and is in prison since 11.8.2014.

The petitioner filed Bail Petition No. 834 of 2014 in the court of Additional Sessions Judge III, Vaishali and the same was dismissed on 28.8.2014. Hence, this application.

The allegations against the petitioner are only referable to Section 498-A, IPC. In the recent past Hon'ble Supreme Court held that arrest and continued detention, in cases registered under Section 498-A, IPC is almost unwarranted. Therefore, further detention of the petitioner is not at all warranted.

Hence, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall

be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Hajipur Mahila P S Case No. 36 of 2013.
