No doubt, petitioner is named in the first information report with allegation that he along with others took the deceased from his house but even if the aforesaid allegation assumed to be true, then also, it is a case of last seen and moreover, having more or less similar allegation co-accused Yogi Yadav has already been granted privilege of bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court.
