ORAL ORDER

3 20-01-2015 Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners seek bail in a case instituted for the offence under Section(s) 387, 511, 120B, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering that the entire case is based on materials which have been collected and the Petitioners' brother



undertakes responsibility for them, let the Petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- (Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by the Court below to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Buxar Mufassil P.S. Case No. 152 of 2014 subject to the conditions (i) that one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioners, who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioners. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the court about any change in the address of the petitioners, (ii) that the bailors shall also state on affidavit that they will inform the court concerned if the petitioners are implicated in any other case of similar nature after their release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse,(iii) that the petitioners will give an undertaking that they will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if they fail to do so on two given dates and delay the trial in any manner, their bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse, and (iv) that the petitioners will be well represented on each date and if they fail to do so on two

consecutive dates, their bail will be liable to be cancelled.

In view of the antecedents of the petitioners, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Superintendent of Police, Buxar within fifteen days of their release with a copy of this order and every two weeks thereafter for the next nine months. The conduct of the petitioners will be kept under watch in this period by the Superintendent of Police concerned and if it is found wanting in any respect, a report shall be made to the Court concerned by him to initiate a proceeding for cancellation of bail for reasons of misuse of bail. After reporting to the Superintendent of Police, Buxar certificate will be filed by the petitioner before the Court concerned.
