Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the  
offence punishable under Sections 304(B), 201/34 of IPC.

Allegation against the petitioner is to have demanded  
dowry and due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry Geeta Devi  
sister of the informant has been killed and her dead body has been  
disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there  
was some altercation between the petitioner and his wife, deceased  
and thereafter she took poison. When the petitioner came to know  
he was taking the deceased to the hospital while she died in the  
way to the hospital.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there is

material in the case-diary to show that the deceased has been killed due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry. After investigation charge-sheet has been submitted.

Considering the facts and circumstances, in my opinion, the petitioner does not deserve bail at this stage. His prayer for bail is rejected.
