This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioner, namely, Kailu Kumar, in connection with Amarpur Police Station Case No.227 of 2014, under Section 399, 402, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a /26/35 of the Arms Act, pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka.

Perused the above application and materials on record.

Heard Mr. Avinash, learned Counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. Sunil Kumar Pandey, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

Having regard to the nature of incriminating materials, which have been unearthed against the petitioner,
