The petitioner seeks bail in a case under section 364 of the I.P.C. Later on, sections 302 and 201/34 of the I.P.C. were added.

It is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner figured in the confessional statement of Raj Kumar Mahto in paragraph no.36 of the case diary. Except the confessional statement, the police could not collect any material to show the involvement of the petitioner. It is submitted that Raj Kumar Mahto has already been enlarged on bail by the court below.

Considering the fact that except the confessional statement, the police could not collect any evidence to show the involvement of the petitioner, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Begusarai, in Begusarai(Town) P.S. Case No. 685/2013.
